| Leo & Lucy Low-Profile: Like to work behind the scenes, kitchen, set up, cleanup, or work that can be done at home and handed off to someone else... | Tommy & Tammy Title: Love to be in charge, as long as they have people to do the real work, like getting volunteers and organizing the event. Like to be out front glad-handing with the customers. |
| Frank & Fran Fraternalist: Will work almost all Moose Events because it is the Moose! | Ben & Betty Best Friends: Will volunteer to work with a certain person, a close friend. Will not work if that person can't make it. (Their Friend can be any of the other types.) |
| Bill & Bonnie Believer: Believe in certain causes, and will volunteer for most events that support their particular cause, whether with the Moose or not. | Cal & Carla Crafty: Have the talent for and love to make crafts; artwork, centerpieces, decorations. |
| Paul & Paula Party People: Want to work any of the "Fun" events. Don't look for them on a cleanup day. | Sam & Sarah Senior: Like to help, but just not physically as able as they used to be. Want to help with jobs that are not too strenuous or tiring. |
