WALLACE F. McLAMB

Wallace F. McLamb serves on the Moose Charities Board of Directors. He was appointed to this post in July 2007 at the 119th International Convention in Orlando. Prior to this appointment, McLamb had served as Chief Justice of the Supreme Forum since 2006; he had served as a Justice since 2003.

Wallace joined Newport News, VA Lodge 1119 in 1983 and eventually served through every board position including Governor. He elevated to Hampton Roads Moose Legion 199 and eventually served as its President. He is a member of the 50 Division of the Moose 25 Club, and holds the Moose Legion Medal of Honor.

Wallace has also served as Treasurer, Prelate, Vice President and President of the Virginia Moose Association; he also represented Virginia as Deputy Supreme Governor.

On a fraternity-wide basis, Wallace has been a Moose Legion Ambassador and a Commissioner serving the General Governor's office. He received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1990, and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1997.

Wallace, an experienced pilot, is a U.S. Air Force veteran of the Vietnam War.

Holding two bachelor's degrees – in business administration from the University of Tennessee and in political science from Christopher Newport University – Wallace earned his law degree from the College of William and Mary in Williamsburg, VA. He is a court-appointed advocate for Juvenile and Domestic-Relations Court in Virginia, and is a member of the Veterans Administration Hospital Advisory Board.

Wallace is single and resides in Hampton, VA.
