Robert A. Neff serves Moose International as Director of Ritual & Higher Degrees. He was appointed to this position March 2011. Prior to this he had served since January 2010 as Director of the Moose Legion. He served as a member of the Mooseheart Board of Directors 2007-2010; before that, he had served on the International Moose Legion Council since 1999 and as International President of the Moose Legion in 2005-2006.

Bob, a native of Princeton, IL, in 1979 joined Lockport, IL Lodge 1557, where he holds a Life Membership, and elevated in 1980 to Mecca (IL) Moose Legion 9, where he also holds a Life Membership.
