What is TIPS?

TIPS (Training for Intervention Procedures) is a dynamic, skills-based training program designed to prevent intoxication, drunk driving, and underage drinking by enhancing the fundamental “people skills” of those who serve alcohol in your lodge. Employees and managers who participate are able to:

- Recognize signs of intoxication.
- Spot underage drinkers and prevent sales to minors.
- Effectively intervene to prevent problem situations.
- Handle refusal situations with greater confidence.

How does my Lodge benefit?

Lodges that use TIPS benefit immediately by reducing risk and creating a safer, more responsible work environment.

TIPS training can:

- Reduce exposure to alcohol liability lawsuits.
- Reduce penalties for alcohol violations.
- Improve customer service and satisfaction.
- Enhance a Lodge’s community image.

When you serve alcohol, know the risks:

- Risk lawsuits if you overserve.
- Risk lives if you serve a drunk driver.
