**GEORGE W. McCULLOUGH, III**

Past Supreme Governor George W. McCullough, III serves on the Moose Foundation Board of Directors for the Loyal Order of Moose. Jeepy was appointed to this post in July 2018 at the 130<sup>th</sup> International Convention in New Orleans, Louisiana. Prior to this post, he served as the Chairman of the Moose Charities Board of Directors (2013-2018); the Pilgrim Council (2012-2013); Jr. Past Supreme Governor (2011-2012); Supreme Governor (2010-2011); Supreme Jr. Governor (2009-2010); Supreme Prelate (2008-2009), Supreme Council (2000-2008), and Chairman of both the Supreme Council Finance Committee, and Audit Committee.

G.W. is a Life Member of Charlotte, NC Lodge 1113, having been sponsored by his father in 1969. He immediately took an active role, serving on all standing and special committees and holding all chairs, including Past Governor. G.W. has been an active Ritualist for more than 25 years, and has been honored as an International Champion in Moose Legion Ritual Competition.

G.W. served on all committees and chairs of Wenoca Moose Legion 78 and is a Past North Moose, and later a Past Moose Legion President by service.

G.W. served the North Carolina Moose Association on several District committee posts, as District President and on most Association Committees. He is a Past President of the Association by service, he has also been conferred the honor of Past President by the Alabama, Louisiana and Minnesota Moose Associations.

G.W. served on the International Community Service Committee before his appointment to the Mooseheart Board of Directors in 1994. A member of the 175 Division of the Moose 25 Club, he received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1978 and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1990. He was awarded the Shining Star as International Moose of the Year for 1995.

G.W., an ordained minister of the Baptist Church, is a U.S. Army combat veteran with service in Vietnam, holding the Bronze Star, Purple Heart, Army Accommodation, and Air Medal, among other decorations.
