Mark L. Klein served the International Moose Legion Council from 2006 thru 2014 to include a year as the 2012-2013 International President. He continues to serve since 2006, in the capacity of Moose Legion Area Manager in California and Nevada. In fact, he's a 3-time recipient of the annual Top Moose Legion Area Manager award.

Mark joined the Moose in 1970 as a member of Oxnard, CA Lodge 561. He immediately took an active role in his Lodge, serving first as Sergeant-at-Arms and from there, "through the chairs". He is a Past Governor of Oxnard 561.

Mark is a Past President of the Channel District within the California/Nevada Moose Association. He's also a Past North Moose of Channel Islands Moose Legion 175, and a Past President of the Channel Islands Council of Higher Degrees.
