THOMAS C. HATCHER

Past Supreme Governor Thomas C. Hatcher serves the Loyal Order of Moose as a member of the Pilgrim Council. He was appointed to this post in May 2013 at the 125th International Convention in Milwaukee. Prior to this post Tom served as Chairman of the Mooseheart Board of Directors. Tom has served on the Pilgrim Council and, in 2006-07, as Pilgrim Governor.

Tom served as Supreme Governor, the fraternity's chief presiding officer, during the 2003-2004 Moose year; he had before that served on the Supreme Council since June 1992. Prior to this, he had served on the Mooseheart Board of Directors and the Mooseheart/Moosehaven Endowment Fund Board.

Tom joined the Moose in 1960 as a member of East Hartford, CT Lodge 1477; he holds a Life Membership. He served as Treasurer, Prelate, and Secretary, and was Chairman of the Fellowship, Publicity, Civic Affairs (now Community Service), Entertainment, Endowment, and Ritual committees. An active Ritualist himself, Tom was a member of the International championship team in 1970. He has placed in the top three on eight different occasions and in three different positions. Tom also holds membership at St. Johnsbury, VT Lodge 1779, Capitol Region, MD Lodge 2680, and Myrtle Beach, SC Lodge 1959. He has been a member of Hy D Davis Moose Legion 8 since 1961; he holds a Life Membership.

Tom served the Connecticut Moose Association as Chairman of the Civic Affairs (now Community Service), By-laws, and Endowment Fund committees. He is a Past President of the Association.

A member of the 250 Division of the Moose 25 Club, Tom received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1965 and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1973.

Tom has served as chairman for the March of Dimes in East Hartford. He also is member of SAE and SME, and is a past president of Hartford Branch Civic Surface Finishing. Tom also belongs to the Lions and the Elks. He enjoys golf, trap shooting, fishing, and watching baseball and football in his spare time.

Tom resides in Glastonbury, CT. He and his late wife Audrey are the parents of three sons Thomas, Timothy and late son Daniel; his family also includes nine grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.
