



ASSOCIATION CHAIRMAN RESPONSIBILITIES

Association Chairman should strive to:

1. **Help veterans become identified / help Administrators with this as needed:**
2. **Encourage and support Lodge Administrators & Chapter Recorders** in fully implementing all program components in their lodges; in as many lodges as possible in the Association;
3. **Encourage and facilitate the formation of activity groups** in the lodges to help bring the program alive in a more concrete way;
4. **Identify opportunities and plan activities in which all veterans from the Association can collectively serve non-Moose veterans** alongside each other. This will increase camaraderie and the presence of Moose veterans in the community, raising more awareness for both veterans' causes and for the Moose;
5. **Facilitate meetings among multiple VV groups** to help generate new ideas and build more camaraderie (i.e. District meetings, Association meetings);
6. **Identify ways that Valued Veterans can support each other and to get each other connected to resources** that some veterans may not know exist, or may not know they're entitled to. Perhaps during meetings people can share challenges they're facing, and others can share solutions they've found;
7. **Identify opportunities to enjoy therapeutic activities together** (i.e. *Project Healing Waters Fly Fishing, VetTix, Combat Bikesaver, etc...*).
