WELCOME

- Welcome to the Moose International Valued Veterans { **Spring / Fall “ recognition ceremony ”** }
- Moose Lodges across North America are celebrating with similar events to bring honor, recognition and, ultimately, support to our own Moose Valued Veterans.
- Introduction of any attending Moose Dignitaries
- Introduction of the **Prelate who offers a prayer**
- After prayer, welcoming officer introduces dignitary / whoever is presiding over duration of ceremony.

OPENING COMMENTS (from Moose Dignitary)

- Tonight we recognize all veterans, but we offer special recognition to those Moose veterans who have become identified in their membership records as veterans between { **Oct 1st – Feb 28th / March 1 – Sept 30th** }
- If you are a Moose veteran and have not yet been identified as a veteran, please be sure to leave your name and Moose membership ID number on the sign-up sheet and we will send that information in to Moose International for you so that you can receive your special recognition in the next semi-annual recognition ceremony.

Presentation of Collective Offering to all LOOM & WOTM VVs i.e. **Wall of Honor** mural & veteran photos, or **Quilt of Valor**.....Saying “*Veterans thank you for your service.*”

Will everyone please rise –for the Presentation of the Colors / National Anthem / You may all be seated

Introduction of Veterans, offering acknowledgment by each branch:

- The United States **Army**, please stand
- United States **Navy**, please stand
- United States **Marine Corp**, please stand
- United States **Airforce**, please stand
- United States **Coast Guard**

Individual Veteran Recognition – Pins & Certificates (Call each up to podium, name by name)

Special Recognition to Valued Veterans who have gone above and beyond to serve humanity in civilian life, particularly through Moose Heart of the Community initiatives. (State what they did, ask them to stand to be recognized).

***** For NOVEMBER CEREMONY ONLY *** “THE VALUED VETERAN OF THE YEAR” is recognized**

> This person was nominated by the general membership, and voted upon by a committee comprised of lodge and chapter officers, lodge and chapter community service committees and chairmen.
