SCOTT A. CUSHING

Scott Cushing serves the Moose as the Supreme Forum Chief Justice. He was appointed to this position in July 2021 at the 133rd International Moose Convention in Cincinnati, Ohio. Prior to this post, Scott served as a Justice on the Supreme Forum from 2018-2021.

He joined Carol City, Florida Lodge No. 1844 as a Charter Member in 1962, serving as Governor in 1964-65. Scott elevated to South Florida Moose Legion No. 46 in 1963 and has served through its officers' chairs, including North Moose in 1983-84.

He served our fraternity as a member of the Moose Legion Council and was installed as International Moose Legion President in 1995. He is an accomplished Ritualist both on the Lodge and Moose Legion level, having won first place in State competitions as Lodge Ritual Governor and was most recently a part of the Championship Team for Moose Legion Ritual at the 2015 and 2021 International Competition. Scott holds both the Moose Legion Medal of Honor and the Elite Ring.

Scott is a Past President of the Florida Bermuda Moose Association; having also served as District President, Resolutions Chairman and Deputy Supreme Governor. In 1998 he was appointed by Director General Paul J. O'Halloren to assist with the inaugural "First Say No to Drugs" Student Congress held in Florida. He was elected to the position of FBMA Secretary in October of 2003 and continues to serve as Assistant Secretary today.

Scott is a member of the 200 Division of the Moose 25 Club. He received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1967 and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1980.

For his steadfast loyalty and service to the Moose Fraternity, Scott was presented with the Life Time Achievement Award at the 131st International Convention in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Outside of the Moose, Scott enjoys a good round of golf. He and wife, Maria, reside in Miramar, Florida.
