On **Saturday, April 27**, each student will be given the opportunity to describe their KidsTalks presentations to the other student representatives during the International Youth Awareness Congress session. There will be no adults in this meeting; only the participants and the co-moderators, all of whom have demonstrated success at the International Youth Awareness Congress in the past.

- You will **NOT** actually give a “KidsTalk”; you will simply explain your KidsTalk to the group as your presentation (covering your topic, the props and handouts used, and related activities, etc.).
- Your presentation should include the number of children to whom you spoke, as well as the age groups of the children.
- You will be permitted to distribute any materials you used (we are anticipating 60 International Youth Awareness Congress participants, as well as the co-moderators).

On the **afternoon of Friday, April 26**, the co-moderators will meet with the participants to discuss the Saturday Youth Awareness Congress session. This will give you the opportunity to speak to the co-moderators; who can provide a wealth of knowledge to support you in your efforts.

After the Congress on **Saturday, April 27**, the participants will vote to determine this year’s five scholarship winners.
