

William T. Trice III joined **Seaford, DE Lodge 1728** in April, 1985, began volunteering shortly afterward and has never stopped. He filled the vacant Entertainment Chairman position early in his Moose career and has served on a series of lodge committees. He served the first of two terms as his lodge's Governor in 1988-89 and he served in that role again in 1993-94. For the last 23 years, Trice has served as his lodge's Administrator and was instrumental in leading his lodge through a difficult time in 2010 when the ballroom roof collapsed during a severe snowstorm and considerable repairs were needed.

In 1988, Trice advanced to the Moose Legion as a member of **Blue Hen (DE) Moose Legion 186**. He earned the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1991 and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1997.

A member of the 200 Division of the 25 Club and a Past President of the Maryland, Delaware, DC Moose Association, Trice served as Depute Supreme Governor twice, in 1998 and 2016.

In 2013, Trice was named to the International Community Service Committee, a role he served through 2017.
