**JAMES K. FLEMING**

James K. Fleming is a Past Supreme Governor and serves the Loyal Order of Moose as Pilgrim Governor on the Pilgrim Council. He was appointed to this post in June 2020 during the 132<sup>nd</sup> Virtual International Convention. Jim has served on the Pilgrim Council since 2014. He retired from Moose International as Corporate Secretary, and as Executive Assistant to the Director General from 2006-2011. Member Relations from 2004-2006, Fraternal Operations from 1999-2004, Moose Legion from 1998-1999 and Departments of Membership from 1991-1998. Jim was honored with a conferral as a Past Supreme Governor by acclamation vote of Supreme Lodge delegates in July 2011 at the 123<sup>rd</sup> International Convention in Anaheim.

Jim joined the Moose in 1975 as a member of Indiana, PA Lodge 174. He immediately took an active role in Lodge activities, serving as Secretary, Jr. Governor, and Governor. He also is a member of Mooseheart, IL Lodge 2655. Jim is a member of Penn Progress (PA) Moose Legion 84, and served as North Moose from 1983-1984. He is also a member of Mecca (IL) Moose Legion 9.

Jim was also active at the Association level, serving on several appointed committees and as President of the Pennsylvania Moose Association from 1987-1988. Additionally, Jim was appointed to the PMA Executive Board in 1990, and was one of the state's coordinators for the Moose Youth Awareness Program.

A member of the 175 Division of the Moose 25 Club, Jim received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1980 and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1986. In 1984, Jim received the Paul P. Schmitz Honorary Mooseheart Award from the Pennsylvania Moose Association and in 1990 he was recognized as Pennsylvania's Moose of the Year.

Jim and his wife Karen reside in Indiana, Pennsylvania.
