

F. ROSS FLEET

F. Ross Fleet is a Past Supreme Governor and serves the Loyal Order of Moose as a member of the Moose Foundation Board. He previously served as Pilgrim Governor on the Pilgrim Council from 2018-2020. Prior to this post, he was a member of the Moosehaven Board of Directors (2003-2006).

Ross joined Winchester, VA Lodge 1283 in 1959; he holds a Life Membership and is a Past Governor of that Lodge. He also joined Lake Shore, FL Lodge 2020 in April 2008.

He was active in the work of the Virginia Moose Association, having served as District 4 Secretary in 1964, and District President in 1967 and 1968. Ross then rose through the Association's chairs to serve as President in 1971-1972. He was appointed as Deputy Supreme Governor for Virginia in 1973.

Ross was serving as Secretary of his Lodge when in late 1974 he joined the fraternity's professional staff as State Director for West Virginia. He served in that capacity until his appointment as Admissions Director for both Mooseheart and Moosehaven in May 1978. After seven years in the Mooseheart-based post, Ross moved to Moosehaven in late 1985 as Assistant Superintendent. He was appointed Superintendent in 1987.

A member of Shenandoah Valley Moose Legion 47 since 1961; where he holds a Life Membership. He is also a member of Seminole Moose Legion 81 since 2010. Ross received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1964 and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1973. He is a member of the 150 Division of the Moose 25 Club.

In 2006, at the 118th International Convention in Chicago, Illinois, Ross was conferred the honor of Past Supreme Governor by an acclamation vote of the Supreme Lodge.

Ross has two sons, five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. He resides in Orange Park, Florida.
