HOWARD DEROSE

Howard DeRose was appointed as a Justice to the Supreme Forum in July 2019 at the International Convention in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Howard joined the Loyal Order of Moose in October of 1974 in Princeton, Illinois Lodge #1339 and is a Life Member there. He served many offices including one term as Prelate, Jr. Governor, Governor, Past Governor, Trustee, and four years as Administrator. He was very active in his Lodge being the Ritual Chairman and performing the part as Governor for 10 years and leading the orientation program for new members. Howard served through the District chairs and was elected as District President for two terms and also served the Illinois Moose Association as an International Membership Coordinator for three years. He then joined the Executive Board of the Illinois Moose Association and was elected President in 1999-2000. Upon completion of that term, he served the Association as an Assistant Territory Manager and a TIPS trainer until retiring to Missouri. He also served as a Deputy Supreme Governor in Illinois (1996-1997) and

Howard elevated to the Grand Prairie Moose Legion #173 in March of 1988. He served as a Director of his Moose Legion for several years and is a Past North Moose.

Howard is a member of the 100 Division of the Moose 25 Club. He was called to the International Convention in Chicago to receive the Fellowship Degree of Honor in June of 1990 and he answered the call in May of 1997 to have the Pilgrim Degree of Merit conferred upon him at the House of God at Mooseheart.

Howard was asked to serve as an Assistant Territory Manager for the Missouri-N. Kansas Association in 2014 and still continues in that capacity. He was elected as Secretary for the MONKS Association in September of 2016 and he also fills the position as a Moose Trainer and Higher Degrees Chairman. He also served as Deputy Supreme Governor in Missouri (2016-2017). He has been awarded as an Honorary Past President of the Missouri-N. Kansas Association.

Outside of the Moose, Howard is an officer in his HOA and enjoys boating and fishing on Table Rock Lake. He is also an avid stock car racing fan attending races in the United States.

Howard retired to live in Missouri on Table Rock Lake after working at LCN Door Closers for 41 years, leaving as a Process Engineer. He joined the Tri Lakes Lodge #2369 in 2013, and was mentoring the Lodge officers to get that Lodge back in good standing. He transferred to the Branson Lodge #2692 in 2014.

Howard and his wife, Pat, reside in Ridgedale, Missouri. They have 5 children, and 6 grandchildren.
