Moose, Trackhouse Reveal New Car and Race Schedule Today

The Moose Fraternity and its NASCAR partner, Trackhouse Racing, are set to publicly announce the current race schedule for 2023 while debuting the new car design to be used this year on Ross Chastain's No. 1 Chevrolet Camaro. The car will keep its red and black color scheme, but introduces the Mooseheart Red Rambler logo on its hood and door panels to focus attention on the school and campus for children in need, one of the Fraternity's primary missions.

Ross, who currently leads the NASCAR driver's standings, is set to race four times in the Moose Fraternity car: At Talladega (Ala.) Superspeedway on April 23; World Wide Technology Raceway near St. Louis on June 4; as well as Watkins Glen (N.Y.) International on August 20; and the playoff race on October 29 at Martinsville (Va.) Speedway.

Moose members are sure to remember last year's races in the Moose car as Ross started the year with a victory in the No. 1 Chevrolet Camaro at the GEICO 500 at Talladega, and finished the year with the infamous "Hail Melon" wall run at Martinsville to qualify for the Championship 4 at Phoenix to end the season. The video of that move alone eclipsed more than 225 million views and the event garnered 1.2 billion impressions for Ross and the Moose. Further, the No. 1 Moose Fraternity Chevrolet from that race was the top-selling Lionel diecast car last season.

Chastain, a member of Tice and the Shores, FL Lodge 1287 and a Five Club Member, races this week in the Toyota Owners 400 at the Richmond Raceway. The race can be seen on FS1 at 3:30pm ET on Sunday, April 2.

POSITION: Traveling Lodge Administrator

GENERAL SUMMARY: Reports to the Asst. Direct of Lodge Development

The purpose of this position is to provide temporary onsite assistance in the event of an unfortunate or unexpected vacancy in the office of the lodge Administrator. The Traveling Administrator will work closely with the lodge Treasurer and other Board members to ensure a smooth transition while they search for a replacement. This individual is empowered with the authority of a Regional Manager for the purpose of assisting the Compliance Office with enforcing the General Laws. The Traveling Administrator will not become a part of the lodge corporation and will only perform as an instructor and consultant with the everyday tasks of a lodge Administrator. **EXPERIENCE IN LODGE OPERATIONS/ADMINISTRATION IS REQUIRED.**

POSITION: Lodge Enhancement Manager

GENERAL SUMMARY: Reports to the Asst. Direct of Lodge Development

The purpose of this position is to support lodges in the capacity of a “consultant” while providing temporary onsite assistance to Social Quarters Managers and lodge officers by proposing enhancements to current operations and offering suggestion to change as may be necessary. The length of time committed to providing this assistance will be determined by an analysis of the needs of the fraternal unit (customarily performed at the direction of the Assistant Director of Membership-Lodge Development with assistance from the Territory and Regional Managers and Financial Review Specialists as appropriate) and this assignment should not routinely exceed 10-20 days at each site but may be extended as needed at the direction of the ADM/LD. **EXPERIENCE IN LODGE OPERATIONS/ADMINISTRATION A PLUS.**
