Past Supreme Governor Danny R. Albert serves The Moose as a member of the Moose Foundation Board. He was appointed to this post in May, 2023. Prior to this, he served as the Chairman of the Moosehaven Board of Directors (2019-2022); on the Pilgrim Council (2016-2017); as Jr. Past Supreme Governor (2015-2016); Supreme Governor (2014-2015); Supreme Jr. Governor (2013-2014); and Supreme Prelate (2012-2013). Danny had also served on the Supreme Council, the Fraternity's corporate Board of Directors, since 2006.
