Chastain Advances in the NASCAR Cup Series Playoff

Ross Chastain avoided trouble all night long last Saturday at Bristol to stay above the cut line and advance to the round of 12 in the NASCAR Cup Series playoff. Driving the red and black Moose Fraternity Chevrolet for the third time this season, Chastain said it was very apparent in the first stage that tire wear would be a story in the race. Teams were wearing out a set in fewer than 40 laps.

"We survived. For tonight in our No. 1 Moose Chevy, to run those couple laps at the beginning of the race, we were just ripping and rolling along. I saw the No. 16 tank and realized it was a tire wear race. We just had no idea. I think the whole field was caught off guard, but we've got to understand when that's coming." – Ross Chastain

Ross starts the next stage in the Cup Series playoffs in 11th place and needs to move up to at least 8th place in the standings over the next three races to advance. Chastain finished the Round of 16 with no top 10s and has just one of those since Chicago, yet he is still in championship contention with seven races remaining. With three top 10s in his four most recent

New Hampshire Motor Speedway starts, it's quite likely he turns things around this weekend and could re-enter the serious title talk.
