Record Your Volunteer Hours Now on the Moose Membership Mobile App

Exciting news! You can now add your lodge volunteer hours on your Moose Membership app. It is simple to add your Moose-initiated Heart of Community hours or your lodge volunteer hours. You also have the ability to view your previously entered volunteer time.

Have you been logging your Volunteer Hours on your My Membership Records? The attached instructions can help you to do so. This new function, a part of the recently-announced Fraternal Recognition Program, is a great tool for the Administrator or Heart of the Community Chairman to add the hours to the Quarterly HOC report.

Update to LCL Allows Lodge Administrators to See Chapter and Moose Legion Dues Status for Members

A recent update to LCL will allow Lodge Administrators to identify when a female member's Chapter dues and a male member's Moose Legion dues are in arrears. Chapter and Moose Legion enrollment dates will now appear in red font on a Lodge member's record when Chapter or Moose Legion dues are delinquent. Because any higher degrees are tied to Chapter and

Moose Legion dues being active, the higher degree conferral date will also appear in red when those dues are in arrears. Once a member's Chapter or Moose Legion dues are current again, the font will return to black to indicate active status.

New Sponsor Incentive Helps Drive Membership Gains

As the Fraternity sets its sights on a fifth (5th) consecutive year of membership growth, the Moose International Board of Directors has introduced a new, short-term sponsor Incentive. Beginning November 1, 2025, each time you sponsor your fifth (5th) new or re-enrolled member into The Moose prior to the end of the current fiscal year, you will receive a one-time use code that can be used for one of the following:

- One year of your own Lodge dues
- Gifted to another member for one year of his/her Lodge dues
- When using the Online Lodge Membership Application to sponsor a new or re-enrolled member into The Moose, it can be used to pay the applicant's dues and the \$20 application fee

There is no limit on the number of one-time use codes that a Sponsor can earn. This exclusive Sponsor Incentive ends on April 30, 2026, so don't delay on making the personal invitation to join our Fraternity. This program also applies to the Moose Legion and Women of the Moose.
