Attn. Chapters: Form 144 donations should not be remitted via ACH

While Moose Charities has begun accepting donations from Moose units via ACH, this option does NOT include Chapter Form 114 Donations (Special Project, Scholarship/Maintenance, Endowment). In order for the Chapter to receive proper credit the donations must be remitted via chapter check and mailed with the Form 114. Chapters may use the ACH option for non-114 donations such as extra endowment contributions, Grand Regent's Project donations, or Mooseheart/Moosehaven operational donations but as a reminder, all donations shall be discussed by the Board of Officers and proposed to the Chapter membership for approval via the minutes. Electronic transfers may not be processed prior to Chapter approval and approved donations shall be recorded in the Chapter minutes.
