## Chastain Heads to ATL for the Autotrader 400

Moose Fraternity driver Ross Chastain led twelve laps and moved up 17 places from the start of the race to finish 20<sup>th</sup> in last Sunday's Daytona 500. Now he heads to Atlanta this weekend for the Autotrader 400. The race will be televised on FOX at 3:00pm ET, Sunday February 22<sup>nd</sup>. Last year, Ross started 33<sup>rd</sup>, led 25 laps, and went on to record his first top ten of the season in Atlanta, finishing eighth.

All season long, Chastain is scheduled to race the No. 1 Chevrolet for Trackhouse Racing. He will drive in the red and black Moose Fraternity car during four races this upcoming season. He will have the Moose logos on his car and firesuit during the rest of the season as well. The four Moose races are: Sunday, March 22<sup>nd</sup> in the Goodyear 400 at Darlington Raceway (SC); Sunday, July 12<sup>th</sup> in the Quaker State 400 Available at Walmart at Echopark Speedway (GA); Saturday, September 19<sup>th</sup> in the Bass Pro Shops Night Race at Bristol Motor Speedway (TN); and Sunday, November 1<sup>st</sup> in the Xfinity 500 at Martinsville Speedway (VA)

## Moose Training Updated

### **AAC – Administrator & Accounting Course**

organization, with practical instruction tied to what Administrators are responsible for managing. This course now includes the content previously covered in 2-HOTT.

### **MMC – Money Management Course**

Designed for Secretaries and Administrators. This course covers both basic and advanced money management practices, with a focus on doing things the right way, protecting the organization, strengthening accountability, and building confidence in the daily handling and oversight of organizational funds.

### **LLC – Lodge Leadership Course**

Required for lodge officers, recommended for everyone. This course focuses on leadership responsibilities, how to run the organization properly, how to support committees, and how to keep operations organized, compliant, and effective.

We will be delivering these new courses at the upcoming **Educational Rally**. This event is where the updated course content will be rolled out in a consistent format and taught in full. After the Rally, these courses will be available for scheduling soon, we will provide further updates.

Our goal is simple: clearer courses, better outcomes, and fewer gaps between what the General Laws require and what we do in real life.
