QuickBooks Online Subscription Price Increase

Intuit's online QuickBooks Essential subscription pricing has changed effective August 1, 2025. The updated monthly rate for the Essential package has increased to \$75.00 per subscription. Intuit is providing all fraternal units of the Moose a discount, lowering the monthly cost to \$52.50 for our Lodges and \$38.50 for our Chapters and Moose Legions. Previously, Moose International had negotiated a 60-month agreement with an \$8.00 monthly subscription rate. Intuit was unwilling to extend this agreement. Lodges saw the increased cost on their September AR statement, with other fraternal units following in the months ahead, depending on when the first use of QuickBooks online occurred. Moose International continues to explore more cost-effective solutions for the financial management and accounting of our Lodges, Chapters, Moose Legions and Associations.

WOTM Higher Degree Status

With the unification of the Fraternity in 2021, many women question the status of their Higher Degrees if their Lodge or Chapter dues are not paid current. If you have a WOTM higher degree and you don't pay your chapter dues, your degree becomes dormant, the logo will eventually drop off your membership card and you may not attend higher degree functions or events, nor wear regalia or WOTM Higher degree logo-apparel. Remember, Lodge dues must be paid current to be a member in good-standing in the organization. In order to reactivate your degree(s), Lodge and Chapter dues must be paid current.

If you are a Past Regent and don't pay your chapter dues, your Past Regent status becomes dormant, the PR designation will eventually be removed from your membership card and you are not eligible to participate as a Past Regent. If designated on or before May 1, 2021 this could affect your eligibility to vote at Association Conventions.

Submitting Form 166

The quickest way to enter a Form 166 is via LCL. Simply complete all the informational fields, click save and the chapter receives immediate credit for submitting the form. You do not need to mail a copy to the WOTM office once entered via LCL. If we receive the Chapter's Form 166 by mail, we only enter the meeting night date and the date we receive the form - NO other data is entered.

Are my Chapter's Reports or Forms Received?

By signing into LCL and clicking on Forms, you can see all the reports and forms received for the current year. If you email a report (audit) please allow 3 business days to get it entered.

Proper Attire for Academy of Friendship Conferral
