

# Official Communication for April 8, 2026

## Special Thursday April 30<sup>th</sup> Application and Enrollment Processing

The Moose fiscal year ends Thursday, April 30<sup>th</sup>. To help your fraternal unit have as many members counted as Active by the month's end, an **additional** application transmission process (sweeper) is scheduled for 12:00 PM NOON Central Time (CT), Thursday, April 30<sup>th</sup>.

This means:

- All New, Re-enroll, and Multiple Member (including **ONLINE**) applications must be entered and transmitted to Moose International before NOON Central Time on Thursday, April 30, 2026.
- *Then* you must enter the Enrollment Date for these applications between 1:00 PM and 8:00 PM Central Time for inclusion on your April 30<sup>th</sup> active member count.
- Enter and transmit any applications for Reinstatement prior to 8:00 pm CT April 30<sup>th</sup> to be included in the current year's total member count.

## April Checklist

- **Verify Names/Addresses for new member are correct, prior to entering in LCL Web**
  - Can't read it? Contact new member directly prior to entering applications
- **Verify correct sponsor has credit for applications during Fiscal Year**
  - Report corrections to Member Services prior to April 30
- **Verify all applications in "Accepted" Status get enrolled**
  - Any applicants presently in LCL Web who remitted fees/dues and received a favorable vote of the membership, should immediately be transmitted to Moose International using the current day's date as the enroll date. **If you receive a message when logging into LCL Web that indicates you have applications ready to enroll, then you have members that need to be enrolled. Click on Applications-Search, and the applications ready to enroll will appear with an Accepted Status – these are the applications that need to have an enroll date entered and transmitted to be enrolled.**
  - Chapters must ensure that an appropriate ballot date is also transmitted.
  - Remember to check for any online applications during these final days of the campaign.

## End of Year Checklist

- **Blanket Dispensation to All Lodges/Chapters from Chief Compliance Officer's/Grand Chancellor's Office**
  - The Chief Compliance Officer's/Grand Chancellor's Office have issued blanket dispensations to all lodges and chapters wishing to conduct additional membership

meetings in April for the sole purpose of voting on new candidate applications for Moose membership.

- Moose Legion - new applicants must attend a conferral.
- If a lodge/chapter chooses to implement additional meetings, they must take place on or before Thursday, April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026 and a quorum, as defined in the General Laws, must be present. No other business may be conducted during this meeting.

- **Members with April 30, 2026 Expiration Dates Are Counted as Active for Year-End Totals**

- Members with an April 30, 2026 expiration date do not require your efforts to get dues paid. Instead, focus your efforts to reactivate expired members **with a March 31, 2026, or earlier (2/28/26, 1/31/26, 12/31/25...) expiration date.**

- **Online Payments Included In 2025-2026 Year-End Totals**

- Members can pay dues **online** with a credit card, MasterCard, Visa, Discover or American Express at <https://secure.mooseintl.org/QuickPay>. Payments made prior to **8:00 PM CT on April 30, 2026**, are *included* in the 2025-2026 year-end totals.

## **Still Time to Take Advantage of the New Sponsor Incentive**

## **NASCAR Heads to Bristol This Weekend**

Ross Chastain returns to the track after a one week in-season break for the Cup Series Food City 500 on April 12 at Bristol Motor Speedway. Moose Fraternity Driver Chastain looks to kick-start his season at "The Last Great Colosseum," a high-banked, 0.533-mile concrete oval famous for intense, close-quarters NASCAR racing. Opened in 1961, it features 24 to 28-degree banking, seating for over 140,000, and is often referred to as the "World's Fastest Half-Mile," with laps often completed in roughly 15 seconds. Last spring, Ross was in contention here, eventually finishing seventh.

- **Traveling Administrator (TA)**

A high-impact, rapid-response role deployed to stabilize Moose Lodges facing leadership vacancies or significant operational and financial challenges. The position provides hands-on, short-term support (typically 10–20 days) focused on restoring compliance, strengthening governance, and guiding lodges toward sustainable operations. The TA operates in an advisory and training capacity—partnering with lodge leadership, not replacing it—while ensuring adherence to Moose General Laws and financial best practices. Success in this role directly supports Membership Department goals of improving lodge performance, reducing risk, and strengthening long-term fraternal and financial health.

Compensation of \$70,035.94, plus bonus incentives and expense reimbursements, with benefits eligibility on the first of the month following the hire date.

- **Financial Review Specialist (FRS) Great Lakes Region**

A critical, field-based role focused on stabilizing and strengthening Moose Lodges experiencing significant financial and operational challenges. This position conducts in-depth evaluations, provides hands-on training, and implements corrective strategies to restore lodges to fraternal and fiscal success. The role requires strong expertise in QuickBooks Online, financial analysis, and leadership development, while partnering closely with Regional and Territory Managers to drive measurable improvements. Additionally, the Financial Review Specialist supports broader organizational goals by enhancing lodge profitability, membership growth, compliance, and long-term sustainability across assigned regions. Located in the Great Lakes Region with **primary responsibility in Indiana, Michigan, Illinois, Iowa, Wisconsin, Missouri, and Ontario Canada.**

Territory Managers assist with providing training to association and lodge leaders, as-well-as to Moose members in general. TMs serve as first line representatives of The Moose and all units and departments of Moose International, and provide assistance to members when questions or issues arise.

**Territory 4** consists of 29 lodges located within West New York and North West Pennsylvania. The Territory currently has 18,865 members. The Territory Manager for Territory 4 reports to the Northeast Regional Manager Brian Dowd [bdowd@mooseintl.org](mailto:bdowd@mooseintl.org). **Territory 40** consists of 28 lodges located within Alberta, Montana and Wyoming-Nebraska Moose Associations. The Territory currently has 23,418 members. The Territory Manager for Territory 40 reports to the Plain West Regional Manager Plains West Region Manager Shawn Schoepp [sschoepp@mooseintl.org](mailto:sschoepp@mooseintl.org). The Territory is located within the Montana, West Nebraska, Wyoming and Alberta Canada Moose Associations.

**Territory 48** consists of 19 lodges located within Texas, Oklahoma and South Kansas. The Territory currently has 6,067 members. The Territory Manager for Territory 48 reports to the Gulf Coast Regional Manager Jesse Germany [jgermany@mooseintl.org](mailto:jgermany@mooseintl.org). The Territory is located within the Texas and Oklahoma-South Kansas Moose Associations.
