

Workshops Answer the “Burning Questions” at the Moose Convention

Moose International workshop sessions have proven popular over the past number of years and, many times, play to standing-room-only crowds. They appeal to members who are looking for information on specific subjects and programs, and offer the chance for attendees to ask questions that often help lodges and chapters operate at maximum efficiency. This year in Oklahoma City, a number of topics will be the focus of sessions involving almost all areas of the Fraternity.

The following workshop topics are slated for Wednesday, July 1 or Thursday, July 2, although all sessions are tentative and may be subject to change.

Moose Grant Programs *(presented by the Moose Intl Marketing Dept)*

The Moose International Board of Directors has proactively designated \$3,000,000 to new grants in 2026-27. Learn what programs are available for the next fiscal year and how they can benefit your lodge.

Top 10 Questions/Concerns Asked by Lodges and Members *(Moose Intl Membership and Compliance Depts)*

We will be answering the ten most asked questions or concerns reported to our departments. We will follow up with a short Q & A at the end as time allows.

Moosehaven Retirement Options *(Moosehaven staff)*

Many members do not know that Moosehaven has two admission programs and if so, they don't know the difference in the qualifications. This session will answer your questions on which retirement option is best for you.

Mooseheart Unplugged: Behind the Impact *(Mooseheart staff)*

A real, in-depth look at Mooseheart and why it remains one of the Fraternity's main missions.

Learn how and why each part of the meeting is important and the correct way to set-up and use the stations. Discover the typical mistakes made during the meeting and how to correct them.

Wellcare - Information and coverage options for Medicare coverage *(Wellcare staff)*

Your presenter will go over the different parts of Medicare, review the different coverage options and qualifications, and have a Q&A session to help answer your questions.
