

**DANIEL R. WILLIAMS, SR.**

Daniel Ray “Danny” Williams, Sr. serves The Moose as International Moose Legion Secretary. He was appointed to this post in July 2017 at the 129<sup>th</sup> International Moose Convention held in Tampa, Florida. He previously served on the Supreme Forum (2017-2023), as Chief Justice of the Supreme Forum (2023-2024), as Jr. Past International Moose Legion President (2016-2017); as International Moose Legion President (2015-2016), and as an International Moose Legion Councilman since 2010. Danny also served on the International level as Deputy Supreme Governor, Deputy Grand North Moose, Supreme Outer Guard, Supreme Inner Guard and Supreme Sgt-at-Arms.

He joined the fraternity as a member of Glen Burnie, Maryland Lodge 1453 in January 1971 (now General Assembly, IL 3000) and is a dual member of Berkeley Springs, West Virginia Lodge 1483 and Wheaton, Maryland Lodge 1775 where he holds a Life Membership. He served all elected positions at the Lodge and received the Governors Merit and the Governor Excellence Awards. Danny elevated to Baltimore (MD) Moose Legion 10 in October 1971 (now Capital Moose Legion 155) and Gateway (WV) Moose Legion 196. He is a Life Member of both Moose Legions and received the Moose Legion Medal of Honor and the Moose Legion Elite Ring for sponsoring and advancing Lodge members into the “Degree of Service” within the Moose Legion.

At the Association level, Danny has served the MD/DE/DC Moose Association for over 43 years in various positions; including Past President (1995) and the West Virginia Moose Association for over 20 years. He was honored as Past West Virginia Moose Association President in 2021, was Lifetime Achievement Award Selection in 2021 and currently Moose Charities Co-Chairman.

He is a member of the 350 Division of the Moose 25 Club, and 175 Division of the Moose Legion. Danny received his Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1976 and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1991.
