LARRY JANISSE

Larry Janisse serves The Moose as Chief Justice on the Supreme Forum. He was elected and installed to this position in July 2026 during the 138th International Convention in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Prior to this, he served on the Supreme Forum from 2020-2026. He also served the Moose International Membership Department as a Financial Review Specialist, retiring in April 2020. He was appointed to this post in May 2015. Larry also served as Deputy Director in the Lodge Operations Department (2010-2014), Senior Operations Analyst (2007-2010), Assistant Regional Manager for Pennsylvania (2005-2007) and Special Assistant in the Supreme Secretary's Office (1991-2004).

Larry joined the Moose in 1973 as a member of Anaheim, California Lodge 1853. He later transferred to, and is a current member of, Tunkhannock, Pennsylvania Lodge 1276. While a member of Anaheim, he served as Governor, Jr. Governor, Administrator, Treasurer and Trustee. Larry was also active with the Lodge and District Ritual teams.

He elevated to Orange Coast Moose Legion 203 in March 1980, which has recently merged with Southern California Legion 6.

Larry was conferred with the honor of Past President by the Pennsylvania Moose Association in 2009.

He is a member of the 50 Division of the Moose 25 Club. Larry received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1985 and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1999.

Prior to his employment with Moose International, he worked as a Coach Operator for the Orange County, California Transit District.
