One Mission – One Fraternity – One Million

Moose Fraternity membership is edging ever so close back to one million members strong! As excitement grows for a sixth straight year of membership growth, the Moose International Board of Directors has approved \$350,000 in incentives for sponsors, new memberships, active members, lodges and state associations to help reach this important milestone.

Starting July 1, 2026, there will be cash incentives starting with the 975,000th membership signed, with other incentives kicking in at various levels until we reach our 1,000,001st member. Sponsors can win up to \$10,000 cash, paid Life Memberships, trips to the International Moose Convention in Orlando, and more, depending upon the membership level achieved. Lodges, associations, new members, campaign sponsors, and active members will also win awards through this program.

The incentive structure is designed to:

- Increase new member growth across all Associations
- Create healthy competitive engagement among Sponsors, Lodges and Associations
- Reward local membership recruitment efforts
- Publicly celebrate milestone membership achievements
- Generate positive publicity and organizational momentum leading into the historic one-million member milestone

Chastain Pilots the Moose Fraternity Chevrolet this Sunday in Atlanta

Moose Fraternity and NASCAR driver Ross Chastain will be behind the wheel of the No. 1 Moose Chevrolet for the second time this season as he competes in the Quaker State 400 this Sunday, July 12th at 7:00pm ET.

Sunday night marks Chastain's 14th Cup Series start at EchoPark Speedway near Atlanta. He has two runner-up finishes at the 1.54-mile track and most recently finished third in February. In total, Chastain has led 117 laps and captured three top-five and five top-10 finishes. Since driving the No. 1 Chevrolet, Chastain has only finished outside of the top-13 twice - both results were accident related.

"I've been pretty close to victory lane a couple of times with the new surface at EchoPark. I really enjoy racing there and it's so fun. It's mentally draining because of all the jockeying you have to do to try and get in the correct lanes for a good run and get it at the right time. I'm a fan

of the racing at EchoPark, that's for sure. Maybe we can finally drive to victory lane there this weekend after being close before." – Ross Chastain

Prior to the race, Ross will appear at Warner Robins Moose Lodge No. 1688, 400 Carl Vinson Parkway, Warner Robins, GA for a meet-and-greet with lodge members and race fans. The meet-and-greet will take place from 11:30am – 12:30pm on Saturday, July 11th. All members and guests are invited to stop by.

Moose members looking to watch the race can do so on Sunday, July 12th at 7:00pm ET on TNT Sports.

Moose International Grant Applications are Open

Applications are now open for all three grant programs, Lodge Grants/Local Marketing Grants/Sign Grants, and can only be found on the administrator's dropdown menu on LCL web. Lodges may apply for one, two or all three of the programs above as long as they meet these minimum requirements:

- Attendance at the 2026 International Moose Convention. At least one member representing the lodge needed to be scanned into an official meeting of The Moose in OKC for the lodge to qualify for grant consideration.
- Attendance at your Association 2025 Annual Meeting. At least one representative from your lodge must have attended your Association's 2025 Fall Annual Meeting.
- Attendance at your Association 2026 Midyear Meeting. At least one representative from your lodge must have attended your Association's 2026 Midyear Meeting.

Note that there may be additional requirements (membership, fraternal record, charitable giving, etc.) that may be taken into consideration when evaluating applications.

The Local Marketing and Signage Grant Programs will remain open as long as there are funds available or the fiscal year ends, whichever comes first. The Lodge Grant applications will close on Friday, July 31st.

The Membership Department of Moose International, Inc. is seeking individuals whom are energetic self-starters with knowledge suitable to operating a successful business operation; ideal applicants are knowledgeable on the workings of The Moose Fraternal Organization. Applicants with higher degree education in business and accounting; or have professional experience in business – especially restaurant and/or bar operations should identify this education and experience in their submission for consideration. Position requires travel four or more days per week, including overnight travel and applicants must have their own transportation (business miles are reimbursed per Moose International Policy); and be able to read and write the English language. The ability to use Microsoft products: Word, Excel, Outlook, and Power Point are a plus.

Position is paid an annual competitive salary (paid bi-weekly); and subject to current policies has the ability to earn commission and incentive bonus, offers employee benefits that include vacation leave, medical, dental, and vision coverage, 401-K, life insurance, and other benefits may be offered.

Territory Managers (TM) provide oversight to Moose Lodge operations, promoting programs of The Moose and other units of Moose International; Territory Managers also ensure Moose Lodges and members adhere to the General Laws of Moose International. Territory Managers assist with providing training to association and lodge leaders, as-well-as to Moose members in general. TMs serve as first line representatives of The Moose and all units and departments of Moose International, and provide assistance to members when questions or issues arise.

Territory 40 consists of 28 lodges located within Alberta, Montana and Wyoming-Nebraska Moose Associations. The Territory currently has 23,418 members. The Territory Manager for Territory 40 reports to the Plain West Regional Manager Shawn Schoepp sschoepp@mooseintl.org.

Moose International is not offering any assistance for relocation to this Territory and will not reimburse any expense or cost associated with relocating.
