BRUCE L. SNIDER

Past International Moose Legion President Bruce L. Snider serves The Moose as a Director on the Moose International Board of Directors. He was elected to this position in July 2022 at the International Convention in Orlando, Florida. Prior to this post, he served on the Moosehaven Board of Directors (2016-2022), as Jr. Past International Moose Legion President (2015-2016); International Moose Legion President (2014-2015) and International Moose Legion Council member (2009-2014).

Bruce joined Woodward, OK Lodge 452 on October 7, 1996. He has served as Prelate, Governor, Past Governor and currently serves as their Administrator since 2004. He holds dual memberships in Iowa City, IA Lodge 1096, Mooseheart, IL Lodge 2655, Princeton, IL Lodge 1339 and Stillwater, OK Lodge 2089.

He has served as District President, Association Treasurer, Association Secretary and was awarded an Honorary Past President in Oklahoma, Missouri and Mississippi. He served as Deputy Supreme Governor for Oklahoma in 2005. He was in the Circle of Distinction in 2007-2008 for having sponsored at least 25 new members during that year.

Bruce elevated to the Sooner (OK) Moose Legion 147 in April, 1998. He served as Assistant Secretary for six years before being appointed to Moose Legion Secretary in 2004, where he still serves his Moose Legion in that capacity. He was awarded the Honorary Past Moose Legion President in 2013. Bruce received the International Moose Legion Special Award in 2005 and Moose Legion Medal of Honor in 2012. He received the Moose Legion Elite Ring for signing 100 Moose Legionnaires in 2018. He also holds membership in Mecca (IL) Moose Legion 9, Northwest Illinois (IL) Moose Legion 57 and Mississippi Valley (IA) Moose Legion 141.

Bruce is a member of the 300 Division of The Moose 25 Club sponsoring 329 members and earned the Circle of Distinction in 2020-2021 and 2021-2022. He received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 2002, the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 2008 and reached the Preferred Level of the Fraternal Recognition Program in October 2025 and the Power Level in May 2026.

Professionally, Bruce is a retired Building Contractor. He currently is a home inspector and a partner in a regional document shredding company. Bruce resides in Woodward, Oklahoma, has three children, eight grandchildren and 2 great-great grandsons.
