Upcoming QuickBooks Online Pricing Change

Note: The following information pertains to LODGES Only. Information regarding any changes to Chapter or Moose Legion pricing will be communicated once received.

Effective August 1, 2026, the standard monthly price for all QuickBooks Online Essentials customers will increase from \$75 to \$85. **The Moose however, has negotiated a 30% discount with QuickBooks, so your monthly cost will only increase by \$7, bringing the new total to \$59.50, plus applicable taxes in some areas.**

This change will be reflected on your August billing statement, which you will receive on September 1.
