

Instructions for Making Ribbon Necklace:

Materials Needed:

- 8 yards of the ribbon yarn
- #7 crochet hook
- Tape Measure
- Scissors
- 20 or more colorful beads

Directions:

- Measure 2 yards of yarn and cut off. Measure 14 inches and then loosely single crochet about 9 inches.
- Pull through the last stitch leaving about 14 inches. This is your first strand.
- Repeat until you have 4 strands. Knot each group of 4 strands about 3 inches from the first and last crochet stitches.
- Combine all strands so they link up and make a knot about 4 inches from the other knots. NOTE: Do not make a tight knot until you are able to slip it over your head or adjust to the length you want.
- Add colorful tiny beads. Thread a needle with matching thread. Start at the first crochet stitch, ad a bead; and then weave the thread through the yarn to where you want to add another bead. Add as many beads as you would like.
