Charles A. Thulin

Charles A. Thulin is a Past Supreme Governor of the Loyal Order of Moose, having received a conferral of this honor at the 111th International Convention at Minneapolis in July 1999.

Chuck served as a full-time officer in the fraternity's Finance Department for 33 years, retiring as Supreme Treasurer in May 2004. He had come to Moose International as Assistant Controller in 1971, and was promoted to Controller in 1978. He was elected Supreme Treasurer in 1995.

Chuck joined the Moose in 1964 as a member of Mitchell, SD Lodge 875. He served as Secretary and Manager of the Lodge until 1965, when he transferred to Yankton, SD Lodge 1356 to serve in the same capacity. He is a Past Governor of Yankton Lodge.

Chuck joined South Dakota Moose Legion 194 in 1965, and later transferred to War Eagle Moose Legion 68 in Iowa where he served as Herder. He is also a Past North Moose.

A member of the 200 Division of the 25 Club, Chuck received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1968 and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1975.

Chuck, who attended Buena Vista College in Storm Lake, IA, worked as an insurance representative prior to his employment with the Moose.

Chuck and his wife Denese reside in Aurora, IL. They have four children and 11 grandchildren.
