FRANK A. SARNECKI

Past Supreme Governor Frank A. Sarnecki served as the seventh Director General of the Loyal Order of Moose and Chief Executive Officer of Moose International, from March 1, 1994 to April 15, 1999. Prior to this he served as Chairman of the Mooseheart Board of Governors and as a member of the Executive Committee. He served as Supreme Governor during the 1988-89 Moose year.

Frank joined Perth Amboy, New Jersey Lodge 1360 on April 27, 1962, and earned designation as a 10-Star Lodge Secretary at Perth Amboy during his 12 years in that post (today known as Administrator). He elevated to North Jersey Moose Legion 2 in 1964. Frank held many offices of the Moose Legion, including Herder. In 1995, the honor of Past International President of the Moose Legion was conferred upon him. A Past President of the New Jersey Moose Association, he also served two terms as Deputy Supreme Governor.

In 1978, Frank was appointed a Justice of the Supreme Forum, and was elected to the Supreme Council in 1980. He was elected Supreme Prelate in 1986 and Supreme Jr. Governor in 1987. A member of the 200 Division of the 25 Club, Frank received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1967, and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1974.

On May 27, 1996, at the 70th Anniversary Convention of the Moose fraternity's Grand Lodge of Great Britain, the honor of Past Grand Governor was conferred on him.

Frank and his wife Joyce, a member of the Supreme Forum and a former member of the International Academy of Friendship Board of the Women of the Moose, reside in Lanoka Harbor, NJ. The Sarneckis have two adult children, Gary and Linda, and two grandchildren.
