**LEVIS R. HUGHES JR.**

Levis R. Hughes Jr. serves as Past International President of the Moose Legion. He assumed this post after having served as Jr. Past International President of the Moose Legion 2009-2010, International President in 2008-09 and on the International Moose Legion Council since 2002.

Levis joined Tallahassee FL Lodge 1075 in January 1976; where he holds a Life Membership. He immediately became active by joining the Lodge Ritual staff in March 1976. He worked his way through the chairs of his Lodge, serving as Governor in 1986-1987. Levis also holds Membership in Quincy, FL Lodge 2672.

Levis joined Northwest Florida Moose Legion 182 in June 1976; where he holds a Life Membership and became active on the Moose Legion Ritual team from 1976 until 2002.
