RONALD L. SWEETMAN, PSG

Past Supreme Governor Ronald L. Sweetman served the Moose fraternity as Chairman of the Moosehaven Board of Directors from 2007-2013.

Ron was elected the fraternity's chief presiding officer in June 2005 at the 117th International Convention in Las Vegas, NV. He served as Supreme Jr. Governor during 2004-05, Supreme Prelate during 2003-04, and was originally elected to the Supreme Council, the fraternity's highest legislative body, in 1994. He had served from 1991-94 on the Moosehaven Board; he had previously served on the Community Service Committee.

Ron joined the Moose in 1971 at New Castle, DE Lodge 1578, where he served through the chairs, including Governor. He became a Life Member in 1979. He holds additional memberships at Capitol Region, MD Lodge 2680 and Mooseheart, IL Lodge 2655. He joined William Penn Moose Legion 3 in 1972, later transferring to Blue Hen Moose Legion 186. He became a Life Member of the Moose Legion in 1985. Ron was a Moose Legion International Ritual Champion, in the part of Charity, in 1987.

Ron has served the Maryland/Delaware/DC Moose Association as chairman of the Rules and Order Committee, Inner and Outer Guard, District President, and President. In 1988, Ron was appointed as the Association's Youth Awareness Program Coordinator, a position he held for nine years.

Ron is a member of the 300 Division of the Moose 25 Club. He received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1977 and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1985. Ron was awarded the Moose Shining Star as International Moose of the Year in 1990; in June 2012, he was conferred the honor of Past International President of the Moose Legion.

Ron is retired from Chrysler Corporation. He and his wife Pearl reside in Elkton, MD. The Sweetmans have four children and nine grandchildren.
